ECPE

The **Examination for the Certificate of Proficiency in English (ECPE)** is an advanced-level test aimed at the C2 CEFR level that covers all four skills (listening, reading, writing, and speaking). Successful test takers receive an official certificate that is valid for life and is generally used for academic and professional purposes.

ECCE

The **Examination for the Certificate of Competency in English (ECCE)** is an upper-intermediate-level test aimed at the B2 CEFR level that covers all four skills. Successful test takers receive an official certificate that is valid for life and is generally used for academic and professional purposes.

MET

The **Michigan English Test (MET)** is a secure, multilevel test that can be taken as a two-skills or a four-skills test. Test takers receive a score report from their exam center. MET scores are used for academic and professional purposes. The MET is offered at least once a month.


MET Go!

MET Go! is a new, secure, multilevel test for learners ages 11-15. The MET Go! test includes reading, listening, and writing sections, with an optional speaking section. MET Go! can be administered anytime, provided ordering requirements are met.

MYLE

The **Michigan Young Learners English (MYLE)** exams are a fun and motivating way to assess the English of young learners in the primary and middle grades. The tests—Bronze, Silver, and Gold—cover all four language skills. Test takers receive certificates that specify ability levels in each language skill. MYLE can be administered anytime, provided ordering requirements are met.

Michigan English Placement Test

The **Michigan English Placement Test (Michigan-EPT)** provides a highly reliable measure of test takers' overall language proficiency for CEFR levels A1-C1. With six forms, it can be used as a placement, progress, or exit test, and institutions can set their own cut scores. It is administered at the convenience of the purchaser.
